FIRE DEPARTMENT MONTHLY REPORT

February 2015

This month's activities resulted in Station 36 responding to **88** calls for service; **56** incidents were for emergency medical and **32** incidents were suppression-related. Station 36 responded to **25** calls within our section of the Village of Inverness and **6** calls in the other side of Inverness. The District logged **8** calls within the Southeast Area and **6** incidents in all other contract areas for an overall total of **102** calls.

E-36 arrived on scene as second due engine. Crew made it to basement and to overhaul and look for fire in the walls and or ceiling. Crew located fire in the wall and continued to open ceilings and walls, checking for additional extension as conditions worsened. HEFD members were able to extinguish visible fire in the basement, but fire had spread to upper floors. E-36 was later asked to report to second floor and overhaul / check for fire. E-36 overhauled a closet and bathroom on upper floor prior to washing-down both areas.
