## **FIRE DEPARTMENT MONTHLY REPORT**

**April 2015**

This month's activities resulted in Station 36 responding to **101** calls for service; **58** incidents were for emergency medical and **43** incidents were suppression-related. Station 36 responded to **46** calls within our section of the Village of Inverness and **4** calls in the other side of Inverness. The District logged **5** calls within the Southeast Area and **11** incidents in all other contract areas for an overall total of **117** calls.

04/18/15 #00309 24 Rolling Hills, Barrington Hills Structure Fire

E36 & DC May responded to a Box Alarm in Barrington /Countryside's District. The Engine crew worked on various hand lines and a master stream throughout the duration of the fire. D/C May was assigned the Rehab group for the duration of the incident.

04/23/15 #00323 120 County Line Barrington Hills Structure Fire

Tender 36 responded to Barrington Hills for a chimney fire. Crew provided assistance with moving hand lines.

04/28/15 #00337 575 Helen, Palatine Structure Fire

E36 and A36 responded to a code 3 report of a garage fire. E36 and A36 formed one crew and were assigned a second line into the front door. The interior

garage door was found to be closed and intact and no fire had extended into the house. Windows were opened to ventilate passively and drywall pulled from the interior wall that separated the inside of the house from the garage.
