### **April 2016**

This month's activities resulted in Station 36 responding to **85** calls for service; **57** incidents were for emergency medical and **28** incidents were suppression-related. Station 36 responded to **26** calls within our section of the Village of Inverness and **10** calls in the other side of Inverness. The District logged **8** calls within the Southeast Area and **12** incidents in all other contract areas for an overall total of **105** calls.
