## **FIRE DEPARTMENT MONTHLY REPORT**

### **May 2016**

This month's activities resulted in Station 36 responding to **68** calls for service; **41** incidents were for emergency medical and **27** incidents were suppression-related. Station 36 responded to **27** calls within our section of the Village of Inverness and **6** calls in the other side of Inverness. The District logged **9** calls within the Southeast Area and **14** incidents in all other contract areas for an overall total of **91** calls.

#### **5/7/16 16-0304 846 Panorama Dr. Palatine Structure Fire**

Engine 36, Ambulance 36 and D/C May responded into Palatine for a fire in an apartment building. Crew from E-36 performed overhaul duties on the second floor and later used meters to monitor for c.o. on second floor. A-36 was assigned 'medical' and obtained three releases for minor smoke inhalation. D/C May was assigned as "Safety".

#### **5/5/16 16-0298 1100 Brandt Hoffman Estates Rubbish Fire**

On May 5th Gold shift responded mutual-aid to Hoffman Estates for a fire at a recycling facility. Tender 36 set up water supply and pumped out of their porta-tank to feed the attack engine. They also coordinated the tender shuttle.
